


- Torque Wrench

Note: Determine LH assist step assembly and RH assist step assembly.








1. Install the four - U-nuts (3) into existing holes (A) on rocker protector stanchion. Refer to graphic for locations and orientation of U-nuts. Install the U-nuts with the threads facing rear of vehicle inside the rocker protector stanchion.



2. Position the Step Assembly LH side (1) to the rocker protector stanchion making sure the hook (A) is engaged to groove on back of stanchion (B).



- 3. Loosely install the four M8 bolts (4) in the locations shown.
- 4. Tighten the M8 bolts (4) in order as follows: (A), (B), (C) and (D) to 25N·m (18 lb ft).
- 5. Repeat steps 1 through 4 for front step assembly RH (2) and for rear steps RH (5), LH (6).
- 6. Verify correct torque on all hardware.
